(as supplied for Commonweal ONLY).

Winter coat.....Brown. (of special brown tweed).
Mackintosh.....Brown (not raincoat).
Hat.....Winter.....Forms L II-VI Black Velour with
ribbon and badge.
Optional addition: Brown velveteen
beret.
Below L II. Either Black Velour
with ribbon and badge.
OR. Brown velveteen beret.

Summer.....Panama with band.

Blazer.....Brown or striped.
Gloves.....Brown.
Scarf.(optional).....Green, with brown and yellow stripes.
Tunic.....Brown (special shape).
Forms V and VI may wear special brown
skirt if preferred.

Blouse.....White, with collar for tie.

Tie.....Green.

Hair ribbons.....Where worn, must be brown.

Pullover.....Fawn.

Knickers.....Brown.

Socks and Stockings. Winter....Knee-length fawn plain ribbed wool
socks to match pullover.
Forms LV-VI may wear fawn lisle or
30 denier nylon stockings with seam.

Summer....White or fawn ankle socks.
Forms LV-VI may wear stockings as
for Winter.

Summer Dress.....Brown/white, green/white or
yellow/white in uniform style. If
parents wish to make dresses at home,
the material can be bought at Grant
Bros. and a sketch obtained from the
School. Simplicity Pattern 3569. page
784. in the March. 1961 book, will be
found helpful.

Knickers. Up to Form Lower II matching knickers
should be worn: these can either be
bought with the dress or made at home.
Above Form Lower II knickers should be
either matching or white.

Petticoat. A plain, unstiffened petticoat may be
worn by Form Lower IV upwards, provided
it does not show below the dress.

Forms V and VI.

In the Summer Term, instead of the dress,
girls in these Forms may wear the
uniform deep cream "total" blouse and
brown skirt if preferred.
